# Electronics

- Electronic devices cannot be out or in use while we are touring, only with the exception that the device is being used as a camera.
- Please know there will be designated times, in which your child will be allowed to text/call you to assure that he/she is having fun.

### Medication

- \*\*\*\*\*Students are not allowed to self-medicate \*\*\*\*\*
- Only the teacher will carry and be responsible for administering your child's medication.
- If your child requires a prescription and/or over the counter medication authorized by a physician please fill out the appropriate form which must be signed by your physician.
- If your child currently has medication/authorization form with the school nurse, no action is required. We will obtain the medication/information directly from our nurse.
- If you wish to authorize the teacher to administer an over the counter medication please fill out the appropriate form.
   Medicine must be sealed in the original store bought container. Examples: Inhalers, Tylenol, Advil, etc...

# Food and Money

- All meals and admissions are included. Although not mandatory, it is suggested that students bring a reasonable amount of spending money for snacks and souvenirs. (\$50 max)
